PUBLIC NOTICE

IN THE MATTER OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT RSO 1990, CHAPTER 0.18 AND IN THE MATTER OF THE DESIGNATION OF THE AREA KNOWN LOCALLY AS PORT CREDIT VILLAGE BEING BOUNDED BY LAKESHORE ROAD WEST TO THE NORTH, MISSISSAUGA ROAD SOUTH TO THE WEST, LAKE ONTARIO TO THE SOUTH AND CREDIT RIVER TO THE EAST AS A HERITAGE CONSERVATION DISTRICT, IN THE CITY OF MISSISSAUGA, IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO.

NOTICE OF PASSING OF BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Corporation of the City of Mississauga has passed By-law No. 0272-2004 to designate the area known locally as Port Credit Village being bounded by Lakeshore Road West to the north, Mississauga Road South to the west, Lake Ontario to the south and Credit River to the east, in the City of Mississauga, as a Heritage Conservation District.
