TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town  
of Cobalt intends to designate the property,  
including lands and buildings, at the following municipal address  
as a property of architectural and/or historical value or interest  
under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

Municipal Address: Railway Station (Station Road)

Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Temiskaming and Northern Ontario Railway Station, built in 1910,  
is recommended for designation for architectural and historical reasons.  
The most elegant building in Cobalt, the Station is constructed in typical  
turn-of-the-century railway style with long low Japanese-style roofs,  
wide timber braced eaves, picturesque dormers, and an almost classical  
centre section, with its fan-headed window, semi-circular hood, and flanking  
Classical ball-and-pedestal. The T.& N.O. created Cobalt; this station is  
an impressive testament to that founding role.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a  
statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts  
may be served on the Clerk of the Town of Cobalt  
before the 26th. day of October, 1978.
