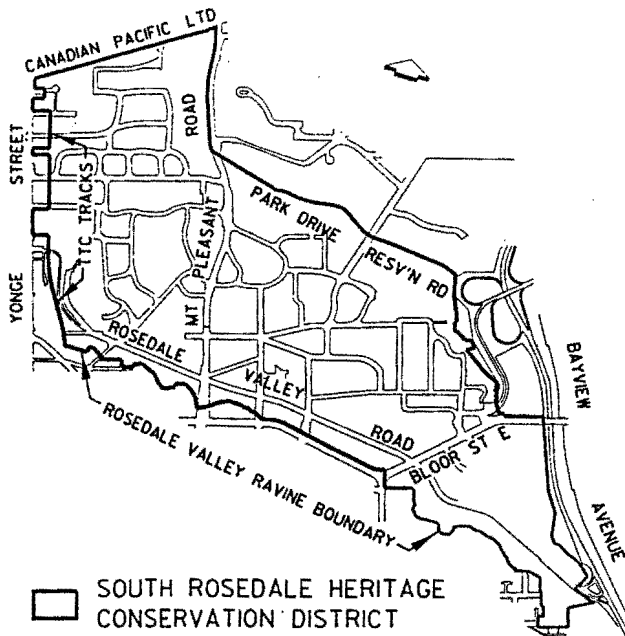

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF BY-LAW NO. 115-2003
