THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BROCKVILLE

BY-LAW NUMBER /65 -79

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS JOHN H. FULFORD MEMORIAL FOUNTAIN, COURT HOUSE AVENUE AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND/OR HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brockville has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as John H. Fulford Memorial Fountain, Court House Avenue and upon The Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the Brockville Recorder and Times, a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks, May 29th, June 5th and 12th, 1979; and

WHEREAS the reasons for designation are:


The Fulford Memorial Fountain is being recommended for designation for architectural and historical reasons. It is an important addition to the streetscape of the main centre of the City of Brockville. Designed by a competent architect and artist in memory of a former mayor of the City, constructed of glazed terra cotta in the style of Italian Renaissance architecture, it was presented to the City on June 11th, 1917.

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BROCKVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. There is designated as being of architectural and/or historical value or interest the real property known as John H. Fulford Memorial Fountain, Court House Avenue, more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
2. The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto in the Land Registry Office for The Registry Division of Leeds (No. 28).
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on The Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.


Description re Fulford Fountain

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Brockville in the County of Leeds, being composed of all that portion of Court House Avenue lying within a circle having a radius of eleven feet (11.00'); the centre of said circle being located as follows:

PREMISING that the eastern limit of Court House Avenue has an astronomic bearing of north 40 degrees 16 minutes 40 seconds west and relating the bearing herein mentioned thereto;

BEGINNING at the intersection of the eastern limit of Court House Avenue with the southern limit of Court House Square; said intersection being the northwestern angle of Lot 16 in Block 31 of the said City;

THENCE south 17 degrees 34 minutes 30 seconds east a distance of one hundred and fifty-two and eighty-eight one-hundredths feet (152.88') to the centre of the hereinbefore mentioned circle.
