NOTICE OF PASSING OF A BY-LAW

TAKE NOTICE that the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Cobourg has passed By-Law Number 07-2003 to designate an area loosely bounded by Spring Street to the west, Division Street to the east, King Street to the south and the VIA train station to the north as being of architectural and historical value or interest pursuant to Part V of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18.

Any person who objects to By-Law Number 07-2003 may appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board by giving the Municipal Clerk of the Town of Cobourg by March 5th, 2003 a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the By-Law and the reasons in support of the objection accompanied by a fee of \$ 125.00 made payable to Minister of Finance.
