Reasons for Proposed Designation

The Hillary House, built around 1860 is one of the  
finest examples of Gothic revival architecture in  
Ontario. It remains one of the best and most  
completed examples of Picturesque Gothic known to  
exist in Ontario. Commemoration of Hillary House as  
a National Historic Site took place in 1975.
