A BY-LAW TO REPEAL A DESIGNATION OF THE PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS CONCESSION 6, PT. LOT 21, RESIDENCE OF , AS BEING OF NO ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE AND INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 31 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1990, Chapter 18 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to re-designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of no architectural or historic value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Seymour has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as the residence of Concession 6, Pt. Lot 21, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to repeal a By-Law designating the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

WHEREAS the work performed on the structure is not architecturally consistent nor sympathetic with the original structure and adversely affects the reasons for designation of the real property known as the residence of the Township at Concession 6, Pt. Lot 21 of the Township

of Seymour in the County of Northumberland being designated as Part 1 on Plan 38R2655.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Seymour enacts as follows:

 By-Law 1984-11 is hereby repealed.
 The Municipal Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property

described, in the proper land registry office.
3) The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.
