Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The house known as "Cricklewood" at 54 Cricklewood Crescent built in the mid 1800's is recommended for designation for architectural reasons as an example of Neo-Classical domestic architecture. It is one of the best preserved houses of this style in the area and retains much of its original detailing.
