This will advise that Council at its meeting held on January 29th, 1991 passed the following resolution with respect to the application for issuance of a demolition permit for the Steckley (Doner) Farmhouse, north side of 19th Avenue, east of Woodbine Avenue, viz.:

> "RESOLVED THAT the report dated January 21st, Building Services, from the Director, for application received advising of an Farmhouse, Steckley Doner demolition of the side öf Lot 31, north Concession Part 4, Nineteenth Avenue, east of Woodbine Avenue, be received;

> AND WHEREAS Huang and Danczkay International Inc. have applied for the issuance of a demolition permit on November 13th, 1990 for the demolition of a heritage building designated by Town of Markham By-Law No. 82-90 under the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act being the Steckley Doner Farmhouse, being Part of Lot 31, Concession 4;
