Description of Property-281 North Street, Port Perry, Ontario

The property occupied by the two storey brick residence at 281 North Street is located on the north side of North Street, one property east of Simcoe Street, in the historic residential neighbourhood a block north of the historic commercial core of Queen Street.

Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest

The fashionable and picturesque house at 281 North Street was constructed circa 1895 for a person of obvious means and status in the community, as it is comparable in scale and architectural sophistication to similar styled homes owned by Port Perry's doctors, professionals, and business elite.

This home and a handful of others in the immediate area reflect the transition in architecture style that took place around the turn of the last century and combines elements of the picturesque Queen Anne style of the late 19th century, with those of the relatively simple elements of the early 20th century Edwardian Classical style. The house at 281 North Street, along with neighbouring heritage homes and their well maintained, lawns, gardens and street trees contribute to the gracious historic residential character of the neighbourhood.

Description of Heritage Attributes

Key Exterior attributes that embody the heritage value of the house located at 281 North Street include its:

- Irregular asymmetrical building footprint;
- steep gabled and truncated hipped roof form;
- dark red machine made brick exterior walls and chimneys;
- fieldstone rubble foundation;
- patterned wooden shingle gable walls with wooden dentil trims;
- wooden scroll cut corbels;
- original window and door openings;
- street facing picture window with stained glass transom;
- enclosed veranda with circular pavilion and clapboard cladding;
- Edwardian front porch with round wooden columns on panelled wooden bases with dentil trimmed beam;
- original solid oak panelled front door with leaded glass window;
