Please be advised that at the March 26, 2018 meeting, the Council of the Township of Scugog indicated its intent to designate Blackstock Old Methodist Cemetery, 3486 Church Street, Blackstock, Ontario, as a property of cultural heritage value or interest under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act* (the Act).

This notice is being served in accordance with Section 29 of the Act.

Description of Property - Blackstock Old Methodist Cemetery 3486 Church Street, Blackstock Ontario

The Blackstock Old Methodist Cemetery is a small village cemetery at the eastern edge of the community associated with the Blackstock United Church, formerly the Methodist Church. It is conveniently located across the road from the old Methodist Church building, and adjacent to an impressive brick Italianate Villa which once functioned as the village hospital known as Dr. Montgomery's "Medical Hall". The cemetery contains 46 markers which mark the final resting place of 77 local residents who died in the 19th and early 20th century.

Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest

The Old Methodist Cemetery has cultural heritage value as the final resting place of several 19th century citizens of the village of Blackstock which was once part of Cartwright Township. The Cemetery provides a good example of small village cemetery that reflects the original 19th century layout and boundaries of the village and its relationship to the surrounding rolling farmland.

Description of Heritage Attributes

Key attributes of the Blackstock Old Methodist Cemetery that reflect its value as a link to the early history of Cartwright and Scugog Township and as an example of a small 19th century rural village cemetery:

- Its original stone markers and monuments and surviving inscriptions;
- The variety of styles, materials and symbolism represented in the markers and monuments ;
- The range of size and sophistication of markers from modest to elaborate;
- · Its location, orientation and dimensions;
- Its well maintained lawn and plantings of trees;
- The simple wire farm boundary fence.
