
Whereas the random course, natural face, fieldstone exterior walls, fieldstone foundation, symmetrical 3-bay frontal façade with a centrally positioned main entrance and low-pitched gabled roof are identified as Heritage Attributes in the heritage designation by-law, By-law 11-2013, passed on January 28, 2013; and,

Whereas the owner has applied to the City to undertake an alteration to the existing dwelling, which includes replacing the existing single door main entrance with a double door main entrance, and a new gable portico with 2 columns; and,

Whereas the proposed alterations would not result in the alteration of any of the Heritage Attributes as identified in the heritage designation by-law (By-law 11-2013);

Therefore Heritage Oshawa endorses the proposed alterations to the existing dwelling, which includes replacing the existing single door main entrance with a double door main entrance, and a new gable portico with 2 columns, as presented."
