Being a by-law of the Corporation of the City of Cambridge to repeal and replace Designation By-law 249 – 87 being a by-law to designate the exterior of RR #21 (655 Black Bridge Road) Cambridge, Ontario, as a property of cultural heritage significance.

WHEREAS the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 2005 Chapter 0.18 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of cultural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Cambridge City Council at its meeting of August 11, 2015 approved the issuance of a demolition permit for the barn located on the designated property known as 655 Black Bridge Road;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to amend the legal description (Schedule A) and the historic and architectural description (Schedule B) for the designated property known as 655 Black Bridge Road, Cambridge Ontario due to the approval and completion of a consent application;

AND WHEREAS Notice of Intention to Repeal By-law 249 – 87 for the designated property known as 655 Black Bridge Road 65, Cambridge, Ontario, has been duly published and served;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT By-law 249 87 is hereby repealed;
- 2. THAT a new Schedule A and Schedule B, attached to and forming part of this by-law, reflect the changes in legal description and historical and architectural descriptions of the designated property known as 655 Black Bridge Road, Cambridge, Ontario;
- 3. THAT the City of Cambridge is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served upon the owner of the said property and upon the Ontario Heritage Trust and to cause notice of this by-law to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Cambridge;
- 4. THAT it is Acknowledged and Directed that the office of the City Solicitor, or his/her designate, be authorized to register electronically any and all documents in connection with this transaction.

5. THAT this by-law shall come into full force on the day it is passed.
