Take Notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto on the 12th day of December, 1983, having considered the application for Consent to Demolish the building known municipally as 145 Yonge Street, and after giving consideration to the matter, decided:

(A) TO REFUSE THE APPLICATION TO DEMOLISH THE

DESIGNATED PROPERTY AT 145 YONGE STREET (WILLIAMS

BUILDING) AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 34 OF THE

ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, PROHIBIT ANY WORK TO DEMOLISH

OR REMOVE ANY BUILDING OR STRUCTURES ON THE PROPERTY FOR

A PERIOD OF 180 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF ITS DECISION.
