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#### BY-LAW NUMBER 104-94 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF STRATFORD

<u>BEING</u> a by-law to designate the real property known municipally as **209 Wellington Street, Stratford** as being of architectural and historical value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337, authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural and historical value or interest;

<u>AND WHEREAS</u> the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Stratford has consulted with its Local Architectural Conservation Advisory Committee;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Stratford has caused to be served upon The Ontario Heritage Foundation and the owners of the property known as 209 Wellington Street, Stratford, notice of its intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused general circulation in the City of Stratford by publication of the notice of intention in a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

<u>AND WHEREAS</u> no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Stratford ENACTS as follows:

- 1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as <a href="209 Wellington Street">209 Wellington Street</a>, in the City of Stratford for the reasons described in Schedule "A" attached hereto.
- 2. The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "B" hereto in the proper land registry office which property is legally described in Schedule "B" attached hereto.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on The Ontario Heritage Foundation and the owner of the property and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the Stratford Beacon Herald being a paper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME AND

#### SCHEDULE "A"

Resons for the Proposed Designation of 209 Wellington Street, Stratford, Ontario are:

Built in 1867, 209 Wellington Street is a Gothic Ontario House which was first owned and occupied by a tailor in this city. This modest frame clapboard house has one of Stratford's earliest examples of the large four pane window. The purely decorative centre gable with bargeboard detail and the front porch have been maintained in their original style. The interior pine plank doors and original hardware are still in use. All of the items listed are important features of the house and are included in the designation. From 1880 to 1971 the Buettenmiller family lived in this house and worked for the railway.

#### SCHEDULE "B"

ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Stratford, in the County of Perth and Province of Ontario and being composed of the most northerly 46.50 feet in perpendicular width from front to rear of Lot 272, Registered Plan 20 for the said City of Stratford.

THE LANDS herein described are also described in Instrument Number 180667 and are illustrated on the attached Survey Plan prepared by F. J. S. Pearce dated January 12, 1977.
