BY-LAW NO. 24-88

A By-law to designate a certain property as a property of historic and architectural value or interest.

WHEREAS Section 29 of THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337, authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact by-laws to designate property to be of historic or architectual value or interest;

AND WHEREAS notice of intention to designate a certain property within the municipality was served on the owner of the property and on The Ontario Heritage Foundation on the 13th day of April, 1988 and was published in the Whig Standard, a newspaper having general circulation in the municipality, on April 13th, 1988, April 20th, 1988 and April 27th, 1988.

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the following proposed designation has been served on the Chief Administrative Officer/Clerk.

 ${\bf NOW}$ THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Pittsburgh ENACTS as follows:

- (1) The following property be and is hereby designated as being of historic and architectural value or interest, namely, Part of Lot 2, Concession 1 more particularly described as Part 2, on Reference Plan 13R-7447; Norma Whitney, owner.
- (2) This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the day of passing.
