**That** alterations to the property at 7 George Street be approved in accordance with the details as described in the application (P18-089- 2022), which was deemed completed on August 5, 2022 with said alterations to include:

1. Replacement of existing asphalt roofing on the detached garage and principal building with exposed fastener metal roofing from VicWest in the same grey/charcoal colour; and
