NOTICE OF DECISION

Re: Approval of Heritage Permit Application HP-2022-01 under Section 33 of the Ontario Heritage Act, at Township of King Council Meeting on January 9, 2023 Alteration to Marylake Augustinian Father Gates, 13760 Keele Street, King City, ON

Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of King on January 9, 2023, having considered an alteration application for 13760 Keele Street, a designated property under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, approved the following:

- 1. That Growth Management Services Report GMS-PL-2023-01 be received;
- 2. That the Heritage Permit for 13760 Keele Street **BE APPROVED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:**
 - That a review of the works be carried out by a Heritage Peer Reviewer retained by the Township in consultation with the Heritage Advisory Committee; and
 - That the review costs and expenses be recovered from the property owner; and
 - That the actionable recommendations from the Heritage Peer Review report be implemented by the property owner within a set timeframe, to the satisfaction of the Director of Growth Management Services, and in consultation with the Heritage Advisory Committee.

As required under Section 33(6)(b) of the Ontario Heritage Act, the Township of King is hereby providing notice of its decision to the property owner and the Ontario Heritage Trust.

Appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal

The Ontario Heritage Act states that where a Council consents to an application to alter a designated property with certain terms or conditions, or refuses the application, the property owner may, within thirty (30) days after receipt of this notice, appeal the Council's decision to the Ontario Land Tribunal by giving a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the decision and the reasons in support of the objection.

The property owner may request a hearing before the Ontario Land Tribunal ("OLT"), by submitting a Notice of Appeal to the OLT (<u>Appeal form 1A</u>), and the Township of King Clerk: Attention Denny Timm, Township Clerk, 2585 King Road, King City, ON, L7B 1A1, by 4.30 p.m. on or before **Thursday, February, 16th, 2023**.
