NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE



Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, on the 17th and 19th days of September, 1975, decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as Rear of 1408A Yonge Street, as a property of architectural value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122. The reason for the proposed designation is not only because it is an interesting octagonal building and a good example of the revived Gothic style, but also because it is the work of an important Toronto architect of the mid-nineteenth century. The Building also has contextual and historical importance as the focal point of Toronto's oldest Roman Catholic cemetery.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of September 26th 1975.
