Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, on the 31st day of January and 1st day of February, 1977, decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as No.139 Front Street East, as a property of architectural value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, 1974 S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

Ferro Machinery Co. Limited industrial building, built in the 1870s, extends the design of the structure to the east and is recommended for designation as a property of architectural value in the context of Front Street. With matching brick details in cornice and parapet, both buildings provide an architectural continuity that is simple and dignified. This building is an important and well-preserved element of the streetscape in the vicinity of the Old Town of York.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of the 11th day of February, 1977. (File 1227).
