THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCUGOG

BY-LAW NUMBER 36-75

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BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE OLD TOWN HALL, PORT PERRY AS BEING OF HISTORICAL & ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE.

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WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Scugog deems it advisable to designate the Old Town Hall, Port Perry, Ontario as being of Historical & Architectural Importance.

AND WHEREAS Council's intention to so designate has been duly advertised with no objections thereto;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SCUGOG Enacts As Follows:

1. That the Old Town Hall Building located at 302 Queen Street, Port Perry, Ontario, being more particularly described as Part Lots 1,2&3, Caleb Crandell's Plan No. 22, Village of Port Perry described on Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law, be hereby designated as being of Historical and Architectural Importance.

2. That the Purpose of the Designation is as follows:


The Town Hall, constructed in 1873, two years after the incorporation of Port Perry, was the project of Joseph Bigelow, the first Reeve of Port Perry. Architecturally, the building has many features of Italianate style with a reproduction of the original bell tower now completed. The building is to be preserved for the use and enjoyment of the citizens of Scugog as a cultural centre.

3. That this By-Law shall come into effect on the day of passing subject to registration in the Registry Office #40, Whitby, Ont.

Read a first and second time this 22nd day of September, 1975.

SCHEDULE "A"

TO BY-LAW NUMBER 36-75

In the Township of Scugog, in the Regional Municipality of Durham, (formerly in the Village of Port Perry, in the County of Ontario) and being composed of part of lots 1, 2 and 3 according to Caleb Crandell's Plan Number 22 for the said Village and more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the north-east angle of said Lot 1;

THENCE South 55 degrees 45 minutes west along the northerly limit of said lot a distance of 65 feet to an iron pipe;

THENCE South 56 degrees 31 minutes east a distance of 100 feet to an iron pipe;

THENCE Westerly and parallel to the northern limits of lots 1 and 3 a distance of 100 feet to an iron pipe in the western limit of said lot 3;

THENCE South 56 degrees 31 minutes east a distance of 56 feet 6 3/4 inches to an iron pipe;

THENCE North 62 degrees 18 minutes 30 seconds east a distance of 109 feet 1 inch to an iron pipe in the eastern limit of said lot 2;

THENCE north 17 degrees 34 minutes 30 seconds west a distance of 176 feet 3 inches to the POINT OF COMMENCEMENT.
