THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FLAMBOROUGH

BY-LAW NO. 2000 106 - H

Being a By-Law to repeal By-Law 82-81-H, a by-law which designates the Rockton Stone Barn as a heritage structure pursuant to the Ontario Heritage Act.

WHEREAS Section 31 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, authorizes a Municipality to repeal a by-law designating property;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Flamborough has caused to be served on the owners of lands and premises known as the Rockton Stone Barn, Part of Lot 20, Concession 4, Lots 6 and 7, Plan 335, Village of Rockton Survey, formerly in the Township of Beverly, now in the Town of Flamborough and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to repeal By-Law 82-81-H, and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the Municipally, once for each of three consecutive weeks; and:

WHEREAS no notice of objection has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FLAMBOROUGH ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That By-Law 82-81-H is hereby repealed. 1)
- That the Municipal Clerk is authorized to delete any reference to the property from the Register of properties designated within the Town of Flamborough and to cause the removal of By-Law 82-81-H from the title of the property.
- The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be 3) served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation, and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.

This By-Law comes into effect on November 10, 2000.
