NOTICE OF INTENTION TO AMEND A DESIGNATION BY-LAW

On January 16, 2017, Oakville Town Council resolved to pass a Notice of Intention to Amend a Heritage Designation By-law for the following property under Section 30.1 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18, as amended, a property of cultural heritage value and interest:

St. Luke's Anglican Church at Palermo
3114 Dundas Street West, Oakville, Ontario

Purpose and Effect of Proposed Amendment

The proposed amendment of By-law 2010-020, "A by-law to designate the St. Luke's Anglican Church at Palermo at 3114 Dundas Street West as a property of historical, architectural and/or contextual significance", is to correct the legal description of the property.

Legal Description

In the Town of Oakville in the Regional Municipality of Halton, property description as follows:
