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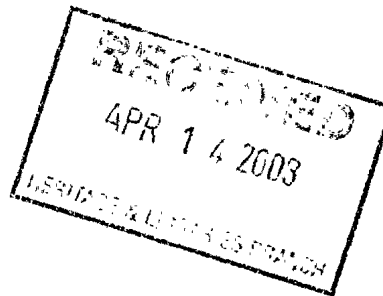

**NOTICE OF INTENTION**

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener intends to pass a by-law to amend Schedule "A" of By-law 92-242 which designates **115 Woodside Avenue (Harry Class Pool)** as being of historic and architectural significance under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter O.18, as amended. The amending by-law will correct the legal description of the land designated so as only to apply to the lands known municipally as 115 Woodside Avenue.

Any person may send by Registered Mail or deliver to the Clerk of the City of Kitchener, Notice of his or her objections to the proposed amending by-law, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts, to be received by the Clerk not later than the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May 2003. When a Notice of Objection has been received, the Council of the Corporation of the City of Kitchener will refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing and report.
