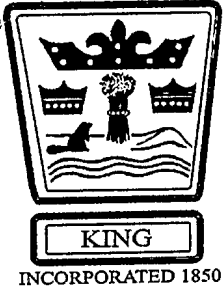

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE PROPERTY  
UNDER THE *ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT***

In the matter of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.O.18 as amended and in the matter of lands and premises as described below in the Township of King, in the Regional Municipality of York, Province of Ontario:

The Township of King Heritage Committee wish to advise King Township Council that the cemeteries listed above are recommended for designation for their cultural heritage value or interest under Part IV of the *Ontario Heritage Act*. They meet criteria for municipal designation prescribed by *Ontario Regulation 9/06* under the three categories of design/physical value, historical/associative value and contextual value.

**REASONS FOR DESIGNATION:**

*Statement of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest*

The cultural heritage value of the Pioneer Cemeteries is related to their design/physical value as inactive, small rural cemeteries.

The cultural heritage value of the Pioneer Cemeteries relates to their historical/associative value as the burial sites of members of early settler families . The remaining markers, limestone and granite slabs and columns bear inscriptions and carvings that perpetrate visible, tangible links with the past.

Further information regarding this project is available at the Township of King, Clerks Department at the address below, from 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday – Friday.

Any person may, within thirty (30) days of publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Township of King notice of his or her objection to the designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. When a Notice of Objection has been received, the Council of the Township of King will refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing and report.
