CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 12-2004

To designate the Blythwood Area as a heritage conservation district.

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of April 14, 15 and 16, 2003, adopted Clause No. 30 of Midtown Community Council Report No. 3 and in so doing authorized the passing of a by-law under section 40 of the *Ontario Heritage Act* defining the Blythwood area as an area to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district; and

WHEREAS City Council at its meeting of September 24, 2003, passed By-law No. 889-2003 defining the study area; and

WHEREAS a heritage study of the area was subsequently conducted;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The areas outlined by the heavy lines shown on the maps attached to and forming part of this by-law are designated as a heritage conservation district under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, chapter 0.18, as amended.

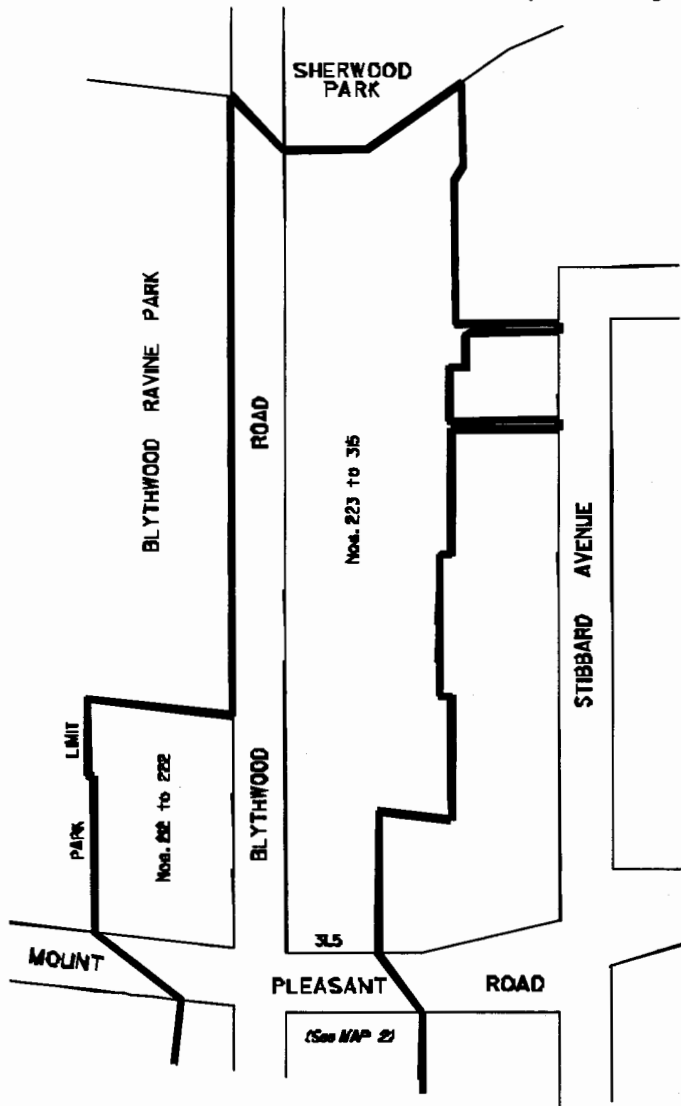
