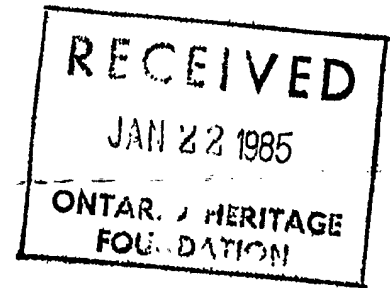

TOWNSHIP OF KENYON

BY-LAW NO. 35-84

A By-Law of The Corporation of the Township of Kenyon to designate the property known as the Glengarry Pioneer Museum in the hamlet of Dunvegan as being of historic and architectural value and interest.

Whereas the lands and buildings forming the complex known as the Glengarry Pioneer Museum are deemed to be of historic value and interest and the said buildings to be architectural examples worthy of preservation.

And Whereas the Ontario Heritage Act provides a means for the better protection of such historic properties through designation, renovation and preservation.

Therefore be it enacted a By-Law of the Corporation of the Township of Kenyon to designate pursuant to Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act RSO 1980 as being of historic and architectural interest and value, that property known as the Glengarry Pioneer Museum, situate in the hamlet of Dunvegan and which lands are described as follows:

Description: Part of Lot number twenty-four (24) in the Eighth (8th) Concession of the Township of Kenyon, County of Glengarry, which parcel is more particularly described in Instruments numbered 8405, 8742 and 27240 registered in the Land Registry Office for Glengarry.
