3) By-law to designate the <u>Cenotaph Property</u> South East Corner of John Street-Eastand Diagonal Road in the Town of Wingham.

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, R.S.O., 1980, Chapter 337, authorizes Council of a Municipality to designate property within the Municipality to be of historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS Council for the Corporation of the Town of Wingham deems it desirable to designate the Cenotaph Property, South East corner of John Street East and Diagonal Road, to be of historic and architectural value and interest;

AND WHEREAS the Clerk of the Town of Wingham has caused Notice of Intention to Designate to be given in accordance with Section 29(3) of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, R.S.O., 1980, Chapter 337.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wingham enacts as follows:

- 1. The property described in Schedule "A" attached hereto, is hereby designated to be of historic and architectural value and interest.
- 2. The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Registry Office.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-law to be served on The Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this By-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the Municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.
- 4. This By-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wingham.

SCHEDULE "A"

TO BY-LAW NO. 2001(1988)

All and Singular those certain parcels or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being a part of Lot Nine, Plan 414 in the Town of Wingham, in the County of Huron, and being more particularly described as follows: -

COMMENCING at a point on the Westerly limit of said Lot Nine situate at the distance of thirty-five feet (35 ft.) Northerly from the South West angle of the Lot; thence Northerly along the Easterly limit of the Diagonal Road Seventy-seven point fifty-five feet (77.55 ft.) more or less to its intersection with John Street; thence Easterly and along the Southerly limit of John Street One Hundred and Twenty-eight point seventy feet (128.70 ft); thence Southerly and at right angles to John Street Thirty-six point Ninety-eight feet (36.98 ft.) more or less to the Southerly limit of Lot Nine; thence Westerly along the Southerly limit of 'Lot Nine Twenty-four point Forty-two feet (24.42 ft.); thence Northerly and parallel to the Diagonal Road thirty-five feet (35 ft.) to the place of beginning.
