BYLAW NUMBER 2008 - 07

BEING A BYLAW TO DESIGNATE "THE WOODLAND HOUSE" LOCATED AT THE SOUTH PART OF LOT 4, CONCESSION 2 EAST OF HURONTARIO STREET, AS BEING OF HISTORIC OR ARCHITECTURAL VALUE OR INTEREST UNDER THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, structures and parts thereof, in the municipality to be of historic or architectural value or interest;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Mono has caused notice of its intention to designate the property described herein to be served on the owner thereof and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the Town of Mono;

AND WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Mono;

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MONO BY ITS MUNICIPAL COUNCIL ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1)The property described as Part of the South half of Lot 4, Concession 2 East of Hurontario Street, being more particularly described as Part 1 on Plan 7R-2398 and Part 1 on Plan 7R-2587, entered in the municipal assessment roll as 22-12-000-005-23600-0000, is hereby designated as being of architectural value or interest.
- (2)The Town's solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be registered upon the title to the property described above in the Land Registry Office.
- The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the (3) property described in Part 1 and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of this bylaw to be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the Town of Mono.
