THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RIDEAU

BY-LAW NO. 77/80

Being a by-law to designate the property known municipally as the Marlborough Township Hall, north east part of Lot 7, Concession 4 of the former Township of Marlborough, as being a property of architectural and historical value and interest.

Whereas Section 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974 authorizes the Council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value of interest;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Rideau has served notice of its intention to designate the property known municipally as the Marlborough Township Hall, north east part of Lot 7, Concession 4 of the former Township of Marlborough, as being a property of architectural and historical value and interest, on the Ontario Heritage Foundation, and has caused such notice to be published in newspapers having general circulation in the municipality for three consecutive weeks;


And Whereas no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the municipality;

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Rideau enacts as follows:



By-law read a first, second and third time and passed this 2nd day of October, 1980.



Property Designated

By-law No. 77/80 is a by-law designating the front elevation and the original internal structure of the Marlborough Township Hall, situated on the north east part of Lot 7, Concession 4 of the former Township of Marlborough.

Reasons For Designation

The Marlborough Township Hall was built in 1855 by Robert Mackey for the Township of Marlborough, and as such this simple frame structure is the oldest municipal building in Rideau Township.
