



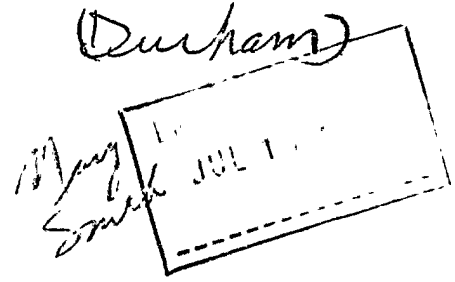



NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

Take Notice that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Clarington intends to designate the property, including the lands and buildings located at 6 Park Street, Orono, Park Lot 28, Concession 5, now in the Municipality of Clarington, as a property of architectural and historical value under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1999, Chapter O.18.

REASONS FOR PROPOSED DESIGNATION

The former armory was constructed between 1913 and 1914 and was a centre for volunteer activity in connection with World War I. It has been a home to various community organizations through the years and forms an eminent part of the Orono streetscape.

The following exterior features are recommended for designation under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act:

- Masonry work with its decorative corbelling and pilasters
- Small paned upper storey windows and voussoirs
- Small paned windows on both storeys at the rear and their decorative voussoirs
- Third floor circular windows and trim

Any person may before the 20th day of August 1999 send by Registered Mail or deliver to the Municipal Clerk of the Municipality of Clarington, notice of his or her object to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. When a notice of objection has been received, the Council of the Municipality of Clarington will refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board of r a hearing and report.
