RE: AMENDMENT TO HERITAGE DESIGNATION BY-LAW 87-15 ORONO TOWN HALL, 5315 MAIN STREET, ORONO FILE NO.: R01.GE

At a meeting held on October 4, 2010, the Council of the Municipality of Clarington approved the following Resolution #GPA-482-10:

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CLARINGTON BY-LAW NO.: 2010 – 127

being a By-law to amend By-law 87-15, being the Heritage Designation of Orono Town Hall

WHEREAS By-Law 87-15 was intended to designate the property known as "The Old Clarke Township Hall" as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under the *Ontario Heritage Act*;

WHEREAS By-Law 87-15 mistakenly provided a legal description for "The Old Clarke Township Hall" that included lands other than lands that were intended to be designated;

WHEREAS this By-Law is passed under the authority of Subsection 30.1 (2) of the *Ontario Heritage Act* to correct the legal description of the property;

WHEREAS by an amendment to The Regional Municipality of Durham Act (S.O. 1993, Chap 3, Section 1), on July 1, 1993, The Corporation of the Town of Newcastle was continued as a town municipality under the name The Corporation of the Municipality of Clarington; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Clarington enacts as follows:

1. Paragraph 1 of By-Law 87-15 is deleted and the following substituted therefore:

The property known as "The Old Clarke Township Hall" legally described as Lot 7, Blk "O" (Lot 28, Conc. 5 Clarke) Pl Village of Orono, Clarke save and except D507737; Clarington is hereby designated as a property of architectural and historical value or interest under the *Ontario Heritage Act*.

2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its passing.
