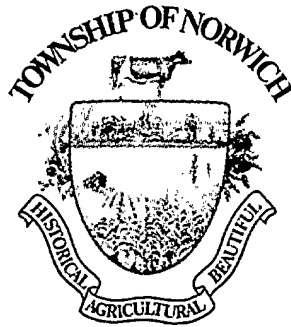

Please find enclosed certified copies of By-Law Nos. 16-90, 17-90 and 18-90, which correspond to the following properties respectively in the Township of Norwich:

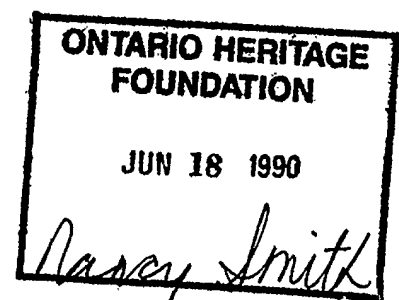
- A. THE GILVESY HOME, Lot 26, Concession 12, former Township of South Norwich

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Norwich
has passed By-Law No. 18-90 to designate the following property as being
of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of The
Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 337:

- A. LOCATION: PORT DOVER LAKE HURON RAILWAY STATION, North half of
Lot 14, Concession 9, former Township of South Norwich

REASON FOR DESIGNATIONS:

This building is historically significant as it symbolizes the
struggle to secure rail service in the mid-19th century to
provide linkage with the world of commerce, education and
entertainment. In the line of communication, one could send a
letter in the morning and have a reply by night.

This building is being restored as a symbol of 19th century
transportation and communication for a small town in southwestern
Ontario. Its architecture is exemplory of a village railroad
station, few of which remain.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORWICH

BY-LAW NO. 18-90

BEING A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE
PROPERTY KNOWN MUNICIPALLY AS
PORT DOVER LAKE HURON
RAILWAY STATION,
NORTH HALF OF LOT 14, CONCESSION 9,
FORMER TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH NORWICH
AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL
AND HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST.

WHEREAS, SECTION 29 of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, authorizes the council of a municipality to enact by-laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historic value or interest;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Norwich has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as THE PORT DOVER LAKE HURON RAILWAY STATION, North Half of Lot 14, Concession 9, former Township of South Norwich, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks;

AND WHEREAS, no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Norwich enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest the real property known as THE PORT DOVER LAKE HURON RAILWAY STATION, North Half of Lot 14, Concession 9, former Township of South Norwich, more particularly described in SCHEDULE A, hereto attached.
2. The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be registered against the property described in Schedule A hereto in the proper land registry office.
3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this by-law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this by-law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality once for each of three consecutive weeks.
