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

### THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PETROLIA

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## BY-LAW NUMBER 26 OF 1996

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY MUNICIPALLY KNOWN AS 421 WARREN AVENUE, IN THE TOWN OF PETROLIA, AS BEING ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, R.S.O. Chapter 337, authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact By-Laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia has caused to be served on the owner of the lands and premises at 421 Warren Avenue, in the Town of Petrolia, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality for one week; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia Hereby Enacts As Follows:

- There is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest of the real property as 421 Warren Avenue, in the Town of Petrolia, Province of Ontario, more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto.
- The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-Law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-Law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this By-Law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality.

Legal Description:

### REASONS FOR DESIGNATION OF PROPERTY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF BY-LAW NUMBER OF 1996

## Historical Reasons:

421 Warren Avenue was built in 1893 by the original owner, Thomas Bicknell. Mr. Bicknell a noted artist of the time constructed many artifacts such as doors, cabinets, etc. for the locals. Thomas' son Fred was born at 421 Warren Avenue. Fred was also a local artist, he made musical instruments such as violins and base violins and played in the Sarnia Port Huron Symphony. His business was a painter and wallpaper hanger. 421 Warren is now owned by

#### Architectural Reasons:

421 Warren Avenue is a typical Gothic Revival Victorian Home. This two story home proudly displays a gable facing north and east adorned with decorative gingerbread. A small decorative porch enclosure leads to the front entrance. The front door built by Thomas Bicknell is a pleasure with its beautiful fan shaped detail. Front and side first floor windows are graced with small square stained glass pieces typical of the era.
