THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PETROLIA

BY-LAW NUMBER 69-1999

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY MUNICIPALLY KNOWN AS MARTHAVILLE UNITED CHURCH, IN THE TOWN OF PETROLIA, AS BEING ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST.

WHEREAS Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, 1980, R.S.O. Chapter 337, authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact By-Laws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural or historical value or interest; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia has caused to be served on the owner of the lands and premises of the Marthaville United Church, in the Town of Petrolia, and upon the Ontario Heritage Foundation, notice of intention to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality for one week; and

WHEREAS no notice of objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Clerk of the Municipality;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia Hereby Enacts As Follows:

- 1. This is designated as being of architectural and historical value or interest of the real property as Marthaville United Church, in the Town of Petrolia, Province of Ontario, more particularly described in Schedule "A" hereto.
- 2. The Municipal Solicitor is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-Law to be registered against the property described in Schedule "A" hereto in the proper land registry office.
- 3. The Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this By-Law to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Ontario Heritage Foundation and to cause notice of the passing of this By-Law to be published in the same newspaper having general circulation in the municipality.

By-Law Read a First, Second and Third time and Finally Passed on the 27th day of September, 1999.

REASONS FOR DESIGNATION OF PROPERTY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF BY-LAW69 OF 1999

Historical Reasons:

The Marthaville United Church was errected in 1880. When regular church services ended in 1928/29 the Marthaville Friendship Circle resumed esponsibility of maintaining the building and held various functions there. With siminishing memberships this practice became very difficult. Because of the istorical value of the building the Petrolia Discovery will move the church as a velcome edition to their Pioneer Village.

Architectural Reasons:

Contents to be included with the church are:

Pulpit – two gas stoves, piano and stool, two high back chairs, Communion table, lymn books, Collection Plates, all plaque's pertaining to building.

n the adjoining kitchen: Cook Stove, antique heater, wooden kitchen table, and wooden rack.
