

RESOLUTION #370-2004

To pass a Resolution that;

WHEREAS the LACAC Committee at their Meeting held, August 19, 2004 requested that Council consider designating property (site) known as the First Roman Catholic Church in the Township of Rideau Lakes (Ward of North Crosby) and being in Lot 18, Concession 5, described as lying west of an iron bar marking the east half of Lot 18, north of the Parish Road allowance, North 42 degrees, 12 minutes East. Commencing at this point and running westerly along Parish Road allowance for two hundred (200) feet to an iron bar marking the westerly limit, thence North at an angle of 90 degrees to the road allowance for Parish Road, for two hundred (200) feet, being 200' by 200';

AND WHEREAS Ms. Elva McCann, owner of site, has stated in writing that she is in agreement with designation of this site;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Rideau Lakes authorizes staff to follow through on designating the above noted site as described above as a Cultural Heritage Site.
