

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Caradoc intends to designate the property, including lands and buildings, at the following location as a property of architectural value or interest under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1980.

- a) Location: Cook's United Church  
Part of Lot 12, Concession I  
Township of Caradoc


The attached key map indicates the location of the subject property in this rural municipality situated in Middlesex County, west of the City of London.

- b) Reasons for Designation:

Cook's United Church, built in 1906, is recommended for designation by reason of its architectural significance. It is an example of a vernacular adaptation of the Victorian Revival Style and has many noteworthy interior features in particular its leaded stain glass windows, exposed trusswork, and decorative pressed metal ceiling which have been preserved from the time of construction.

Notice of objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts may be served on the Clerk of the Township of Caradoc before the 7<sup>th</sup> day of Sept., 1984.
