TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Markham on the 13th day of April, 1982, passed a motion of intention to designate the property, including lands and buildings, known municipally as Warden Avenue, west side, Part Lot 28, Concession 4, Unionville, as a property of architectural and/or historic interest or value under Part IV of The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, S.O. Chapter 122.

### Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The Clayton Schoolhouse located on the west side of Warden Avenue, Part Lot 28, Concession 4, Markham, is recommended for designation for historical and architectural reasons. It is important for providing a place of learning in the early years of The Township of Markham's educational system. Architecturally it is important as an excellent example of a one-room rural schoolhouse, built in the Gothic Revival style, and highlighted with brick patterning.
