BY-LAW No. 541-2004

To expand the area of the Fort York Heritage Conservation District.

WHEREAS By-law No. 420-85 designated the Fort York Heritage Conservation District; and

WHEREAS City Council at its meeting of May 18, 19 and 20, 2004, by the adoption of Clause No. 59, Report No. 4 of the Toronto South Community Council authorized the expansion of the Fort York Heritage Conservation District;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

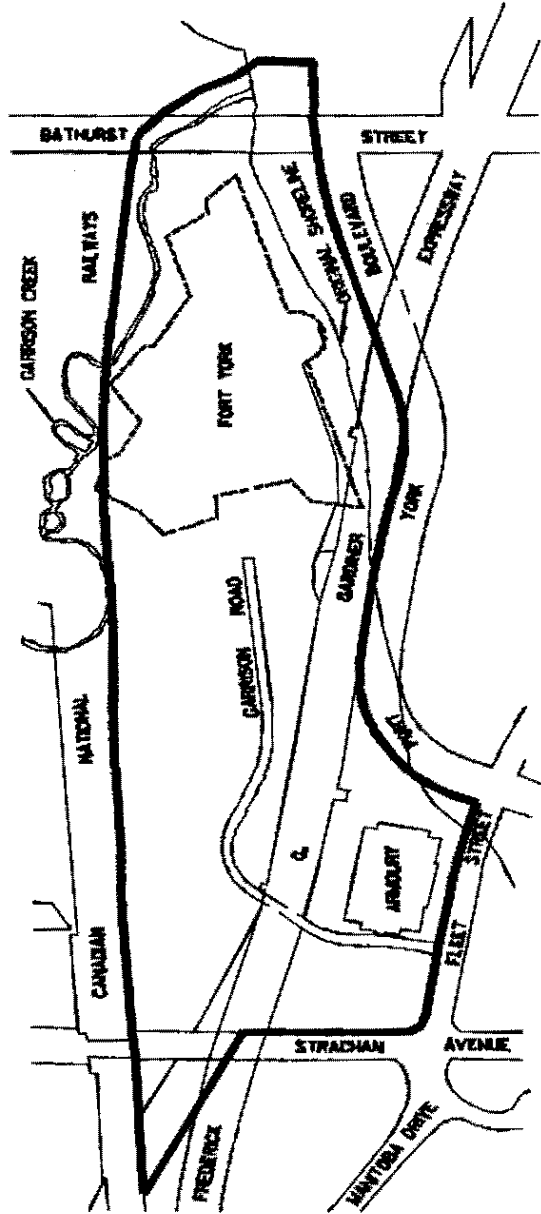
1. The area outlined by the heavy lines shown on the map attached to and forming part of this by-law is designated as a heritage conservation district under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, chapter O.18.
2. By-law No. 420-85 is repealed.
