Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of
the City of Toronto on the 16th day of December, 1982, having
considered the application for Consent to Demolish the building
known municipally as No. 152 Beverley Street, and after giving
consideration to the matter, decided:

1. TO REFUSE THE APPLICATION BY MR. STANLEY J. WAX
ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED JEWISH WELFARE FUND FOR
CONSENT TO DEMOLISH THE DESIGNATED JOHN CAWTHRA
HOUSE AT 152 BEVERLEY STREET IN ACCORDANCE WITH
SECTION 34 OF THE ONTARIO HERITAGE ACT.

2. THAT THE OWNERS OF THE PROPERTY BE REQUESTED TO
MEET WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF THE TORONTO HISTORICAL
BOARD AND OTHER APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS TO DISCUSS THE
FUTURE OF THE JOHN CAWTHRA HOUSE AT 152 BEVERLEY STREET.

3. THAT A PROCEDURE BE ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF BUILDINGS AND INSPECTIONS WHEREBY CONVENIENCE ADDRESSES, AS WELL AS CONFIRMED ADDRESSES, ARE CHECKED WITH REGARD TO THEIR INCLUSION ON THE INVENTORY OF BUILDINGS PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS SO THAT ALL RELEVANT APPLICATIONS MAY BE REVIEWED BY THE TORONTO HISTORICAL BOARD.
