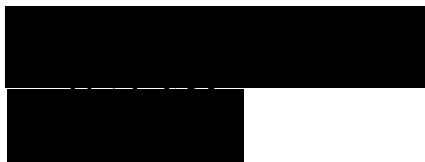

The notice will be published in the Gananoque Reporter for three consecutive weeks and the publication dates will be May 12th, 19th and 26th, 1976.

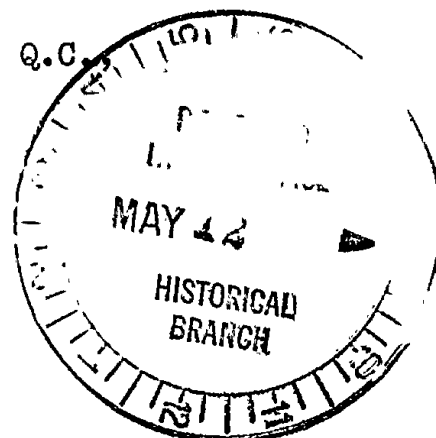
We trust this procedure is sufficient and will enable the Ministry to grant a favourable decision to our intent. If further information is required, kindly advise.

NOTICE OF INTENTION


Notice is hereby given that the council of the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque intends to designate as a property of historic or architectural value or interest the building owned by the Corporation of the Town of Gananoque and presently used as a Town Hall and Public Library located upon Lot A, Plan 86, East of the Gananoque River, in the Town of Gananoque, in the County of Leeds.

The reason for the proposed designation is to preserve a building which is an example of early 19th century architecture and which has associations with the founding families of Gananoque.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served upon the Clerk of the Town of Gananoque within 30 days of the date of the first publication of this notice of intention in The Gananoque Reporter.
