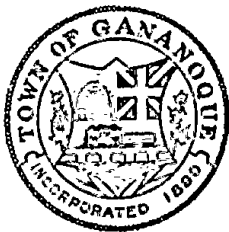

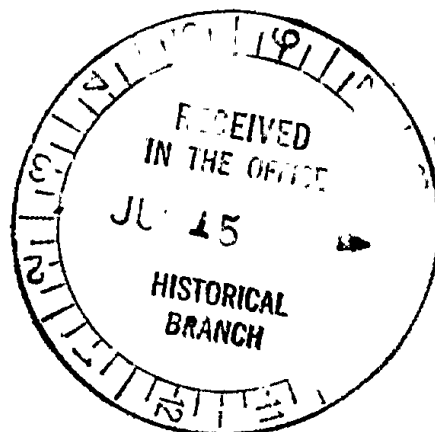

BY-LAW NUMBER 76-13


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of The Town of Gananoque enacts as follows:-




