
Take notice that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Toronto, on the 4th day of February, 1976, decided to designate the lands and buildings, known municipally as 354 Jarvis Street, as a property of architectural value or interest under The Ontario Heritage Act, 1974, 1974 S.O. Chapter 122.

Short Statement of the Reasons for the Proposed Designation:

The former Havergal College (now the CBC) 354 Jarvis Street (W). Havergal College, begun c. 1898, by G. M. Miller, is recommended for designation as the work of an important Toronto architect. It is also important in terms of the local streetscape because of its dominant size and position in the middle section of Jarvis Street.

Notice of objection to the designation may be served on the Clerk within thirty days of the 13th day of February, 1976. (Reference File 1036).
