## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Gravenhurst on February 22, 1982 decided to designate the lands and buildings known as the Severn River Inn, located on Pt. Lot 1, E.M.R. formerly in the Township of Morrison now in the Town of Gravenhurst as a property of historical and architectural value under the provisions of the Ontario Heritage Act, Chapter 337, R.S.O. 1980 for the following reasons:

The Severn River Inn is recommended for Designation for its historical contribution to the community. It is situated on the site of the Original Severn Bridge General Store (1858), Post Office (1861) and telephone exchange (1894). The present building, erected in 1907, also housed these servies, with tourist and boarding house facilities on the upper storey. It is architecturally significant as an example of a combined store and Inn of the late nineteenth century.

Notice of objections to the designation may be served on the Clerk within 30 days of the 3rd day of March, 1982.
