CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 259-2004

To designate the Cabbagetown North area as a heritage conservation district.

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of May 21, 22 and 23, 2003, adopted Clause No. 26 of Toronto East York Community Council Report No. 5, and in so doing authorized the passing of a by-law under section 40 of the *Ontario Heritage Act* defining the Cabbagetown North area as an area to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district; and

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of May 21, 22 and 23, 2003, passed By-law No. 892-2003 defining the study area; and

WHEREAS a heritage study of the area was subsequently conducted;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The area outlined by the heavy lines shown on the map attached to and forming part of this by-law are designated as a heritage conservation district under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, chapter O.18.
