RE: 135 Essex Street Heritage Designation

As you are aware, an objection was filed with the Environment and Land Tribunals Ontario Conservation Review Board regarding your request to have the Part IV heritage designation of 135 Essex St. repealed. A Conservation Review Board Hearing was held February 23, 2016 and at their May 24, 2016 regular meeting, Goderich Town Council considered the Board's report, dated March 24, 2016. The Conservation Review Board strongly recommended 135 Essex St. remain a designated heritage property. After much discussion, Council passed a By-Law maintaining the Part IV heritage designation at 135 Essex St.
