NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Shelburne intends to designate the property at the following location as property of architectural and historical value or interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter 337, Section 29

SHELBURNE TOWN HALL 203 MAIN STREET EAST SHELBURNE, ONTARIO

REASONS FOR PROPOSED DESIGNATION

The Town Hall, built in 1882, has been part of the community's cultural and physical heritage. The Townhall is being designated for both historical and architectural reasons.

FULL CRITERIA FOR THE ABOVE DESIGNATION IS AVAILABLE AT THE MUNICIPAL OFFICE OF THE TOWN OF SHELBURNE.

ANY PERSON may, within 30 days of the first publication of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Town of Shelburne, notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation, together with a statement of the reasons for the objection and all relevant facts. When a Notice of Objection is received the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Shelburne shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing and report.
