## Town of Whitby By-law # 6989-15

### By-law to Amend By-law # 1783-84

Being a By-law to amend By-law # 1783-84 to change the legal description and municipal address of the Heritage Property known as the Anderson-Flint House.

Whereas section 30.1 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. O.18, as amended, authorizes the Council of a municipality to amend a by-law to designate property made under section 29 to correct the legal description of the property;

And whereas the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby has served on the owners of the lands formerly known as 1508 Rossland Road East and now municipally known as 28 Flint Crescent, a Notice of Intent to change the legal description and municipal address of the Heritage Property known as the Anderson-Flint House;

And whereas no Notice of Objection to the proposed amendment has been served on the Town Clerk;

Now therefore, the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitby hereby enacts as follows:

#### 1. General

- 1.1. That By-law # 1783-84 be amended to change the municipal address of the Heritage Property known as the Anderson-Flint House from 1508 Rossland Road East to 28 Flint Crescent.
- 1.2. That Schedule A to By-law # 1783-84 be replaced with the legal description as contained in Schedule A to this By-law.

#### 2. Effective Date

- 2.1. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect on the final date of passing.


