Places of worship of this type have curved walls and/or a curved roof, and are especially characterized by a merger of wall to roof in a curvilinear fashion. Using cast-in-place concrete materials, this playful massing is most commonly found in modern places of worship, specifically Modern Expressionism and Post Modernism styles. Examples: 1. Roman Catholic Shrine at Mary Lake (King), 2. St. Maria Goretti Roman Catholic Church (Scarborough), 3. Hilltop Bible Chapel (Toronto), 4. Sacred Heart Catholic Church (Uxbridge)
