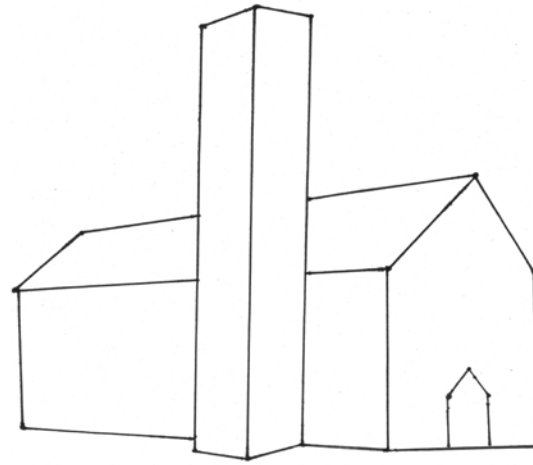


SIDE TOWER

This uncommon massing is often the result of a tight urban site on which the limited space has led to a side entrance in the tower or a somewhat detached tower that acts as a separate form in the overall composition. The tower is typically not centred, but offset to emphasize the asymmetry of the composition. Examples: 1. St Alban the Martyr Anglican Church (Greater Napanee), 2. Grace United Church (Gananoque), 3. Bruce Mines Museum - Former Presbyterian Church (Bruce Mines), 4. St. Paul's Anglican Church (Newmarket)
